Programs

April 21st we will have an electronic imaging critique. Do we want to start an electronic division? Who is interested? Participation in this meeting will help us decide our future in digital imaging competition at Film Pack. We will have a digital projector at the meeting. Here is what you need to do to show your digital images on the screen. These are the same as the 4C's EID (Electronic Imaging Division) competition so you can enter them afterwards. EID Spring Session (deadline: April 30th). 4C's EID entries are submitted via e-mail. For complete information go to:

- The images must be in jpg format.
- The maximum horizontal dimension is 1024 pixels and the maximum vertical dimension is 768 pixels.
- Resolution set at 72 dpi.
- Images may not be larger than 350kb; a jpeg compression of 9 or 10 usually is best.
- Bring your images on a CD or a memory card (CF or MD<=1GB, SD<=521MB, MMC or SM or MS<=128MB). The memory card must be formatted in FAT or FAT 16 not FAT 32 or NTFS so our projector can read it. Also if you have an XD card bring a reader with a USB interface.

Everyone will help critique. If time permits we will try to answer questions you may have about image manipulation and enhancement.
