Here are three short articles focusing in more detail on some of the Pre-Convention activities.

"Step-Back-In-Time" Pre-Convention Photo Field Trip to the steam-powered Hull-Oakes Lumber Mill

On Friday, October 7 you can step back into the early 1900's with our photo tour of the historic steam-powered Hull-Oakes Lumber Mill, just one of the Pre-Convention activities planned for the 4C's Annual Convention to be held in Eugene, Oregon from Friday, October 7 through Sunday, October 9.

The steam engine that to this day produces half the power to the mill's big head-rig saw was built in 1909 and the building itself, which was built in 1938, is on the National Historic Registry of Historic Places. Come join us (and bring your camera's flash unit!) as we take an insiders look at the 60-foot band saw in action as workers cut large diameter logs into planks up to 85 feet long just like they did 67 years ago. If we time it right we can see (and hear!) the start-up of the steam engines after lunch break. This is NOT your usual photo shoot!

Inside the historic mill there will be plenty of rustic detail shots. Outside the mill there's an old wigwam burner, beautiful scenics and a millpond just begging to be photographed. The workers are 'photo-friendly' so grab your flash and come join us for some 'step-back-in-time' photo-journalism that you just won't get anywhere else.
