The coordinators of the 6th annual Worldwide **Pinhole Photography Day** (WPPD6) are busy preparing for the next global pinhole day, and your help is requested. There are a number of ways that you can get involved and help make WPPD6 a larger, more exciting event. WPPD is held the last Sunday in April and the next one will be April 30, 2006. Anyone, anywhere in the world, who makes a pinhole photograph on Pinhole Day, can scan the image and upload it to the <http://pinholeaday.org/> website where it will become part of this premier gallery of lensless photography. Last year, 1815 participants from 49 countries contributed images to the WPPD gallery. Over 100 events - workshops, exhibits, lectures, etc. - were held throughout the world. Local volunteers coordinated all of these events.

Incidentally, the first photographic award that your editor received was for a pinhole image, of some chess pieces, made in high school.

Nikon Corp., which helped popularize the 35mm camera five decades ago, will stop making most of its film cameras to concentrate on digital models. The Japanese company said it would discontinue seven film-camera models, leaving in production only the current top-line model, the F6, and a low-end manual-focus model, the FM10. It will also stop making most of its manual-focus lenses. Most of the company's auto-focus lenses work with manual-focus bodies, however. Nikon did not give firm dates for the discontinuation of its products but said that sales would cease as supplies are depleted. The Kansas City Star
