Hi, everybody. Here are the rules for the upcoming competition.

As a side note, our club digital projector (Dell 2400MP) was delivered yesterday. I'll learn how to use it this weekend and then confirm the rules for this year's monthly EID competition at our club. We do want to stick with the 1024 pixel horizontal and 768 pixel vertical requirement as required by 4C's.

It is time to begin thinking about the 4C's convention and our entries here are the rules for the:

ELECTRONIC IMAGE INVITATIONAL COLUMBIA COUNCIL OF CAMERA CLUBS & NORTHWEST COUNCIL OF CAMERA CLUBS 2007 CONVENTION

All 4C's and NWCC member clubs are invited to enter images for this competition.

A full set of ten images are required for each club entry. This is a *club* competition, and images can only be sent by your club competition chairperson. Awards will be given to the clubs with the highest total scores.

Entry Guidelines

- There are no classes/divisions or restrictions on how the image was made, it only has to be an electronic file to compete.
- Submit no more than two images per club member. Exception: if your club has fewer than 5 members creating electronic images, you may submit up to 3 images per person.
- Submit all 10 images on one CD or DVD.
- Entry deadline is **September 15th**.
- Images that have been entered in a previous Convention Invitational or received an award in the previous year's EID Competitions are not eligible.

Image Files

- The images must be in jpg (jpeg) format.
- The maximum horizontal dimension is 1024 pixels and the maximum vertical dimension is 768 pixels.
- Image file size may not be larger than 350 Kb
