Columbia Council of Camera Clubs Convention (4C's plus 1)

Howdy folks,

The 4Cs convention is approaching fast. The deadline for early registration is September 15th (as long as it's postmarked by then you're fine) so if you know you're going and want to save \$10 that's an easy way to do it. Early registrations will also help us with planning for the field trips.

You'll find all the current convention information-- registration form, schedule, speaker and presentation info, and field trip descriptions-- on the 4Cs website (www.columbiacameraclubs.org), but here is a quick recap:

The convention is being held at Mt. Hood Community College starting Friday October 9th and running through Sunday the 11th.

Early registration for members of 4Cs clubs is \$40. This includes Saturday lunch but dinner and field trips are separate (but still reasonable).

The Friday keynote address is free and open to the public; you don't have to register to attend it. (**Free is a very good price!!**) The speaker is Lewis Kemper, a long time member of Canon's "Explorers of Light" cadre and an associate editor for Outdoor Photographer. I'd especially encourage your members to attend this even if they can't otherwise attend the convention.

There are over a dozen programs by different speakers on Saturday, split into three tracks. Topics will include HDR techniques, places to shoot in Oregon, using Adobe Lightroom, presentation software for both PCs and Macs, creative travel photography, and a number of others.

There will be vendor tables during the day along with the usual display of 4Cs callback prints, and a presentation in the evening with all the award winning images for the year.

On Sunday there will be a few more programs ending with the closing keynote presentation by Sean Bagshaw, who has been featured in Outdoor Photographer and does terrific work.

There will also be 7 field trips:

- o Eagle Creek and Punchbowl Falls (Friday starting at 10am)
- o The Brooklyn Roundhouse-- a maintenance building for classic locomotives-- in southeast Portland (Friday starting at 1pm)
- o Portland Memorial Mausoleum in Sellwood (Friday starting at 1:30 pm)
- o Rocky Butte (Saturday dawn)
- o Willamette east-side esplanade (Sunday dawn)
- o Bonneville Dam powerhouse (Washington side) and Panther Creek Falls (Sunday starting at 1pm)
- o Urban Perspectives in downtown Portland (Sunday starting at 1pm)

It should be a great convention-- I hope to see you and a cohort of FPCC members there!
