There are no classes/divisions or delineation on how the image was made, it only has to be an electronic file to compete. The email submission is the entry form, please do the following:

- In the subject line of the email, put only the complete filename (see "Image File Naming Convention" below) of the image. Attach only ONE image per email.
- The images must be in jpg (jpeg) format. The maximum horizontal dimension is 1024 pixels and the maximum vertical dimension is 768 pixels.
- Image file size may not be larger than 350 Kb.
